EX MIN 20/440 QUARANTINE RULES

Council discussed the quarantine rules for Anguillians and residents returning to Anguilla and agreed that:

- all Anguillians and residents returning to Anguilla must quarantine irrespective of where they have come from for a period of time as directed by the Chief Medical Officer;
- 2) all returning Anguillians and residents should be allowed to quarantine in their own property, irrespective of where they have come from, provided that property passes Ministry of Health inspection;
- should a property fail Ministry of Health inspection, the person returning must quarantine in a Government of Anguilla approved facility at their own expense;
- 4) the PS Ministry of Health should, at Council's next meeting (29 October), indicate the extent of additional resources required to enable the effective monitoring of compliance with quarantine rules; and
- 5) persons suspected of, or found to be breaking the provisions of the Quarantine Act R.S.A C. Q5, should expect to be subjected to the full extent of the law.

In addition, Council agreed that:

1) recognizing that the formal Repatriation Process would shortly conclude, the team working on this should assume responsibility for case managing Anguillians and Residents who had registered on the visitor portal.
