Further to EX MIN 20/118 of 15 March, Council agreed as follows:

- (i) closure of the seaports and airport for the next fourteen (14) days to passenger movements effective Friday 20 March at 11:59 pm;
- (ii) quarantine for 14 days on <u>ALL</u> persons returning to Anguilla who have travelled outside of the Caribbean Region. Persons would be encouraged to self-quarantine at home and call the hotline numbers for guidance if they develop signs or symptoms;
- (iii) public should be advised to refrain from mass gatherings and to recommend guidance on social distancing;
- (iv) closing of schools for three (3) weeks; and
- (v) elder care facilities should enact measures to protect residents, which should include limiting/restricting visitors to the facility, enhancing infection prevention control measures through the more frequent cleaning of shared surfaces and enabling sick leave for staff displaying respiratory symptoms.

Council noted that:

- (i) there were no confirmed cases of COVID-19 virus in Anguilla; and
- (ii) testing for the virus could not be done in Anguilla and was still being shipped to CARPHA. The Ministry of Health was exploring the availability of rapid kits which would enable samples to be shipped quicker.

Council continued to commend the Ministry of Health and Health Authority of Anguilla officials for doing great work in this challenging time.

EX MIN 20/120 <u>DEFERRED CUSTOMS DUTIES PAYMENT ON BASIC NECESSITIES – COVID 19 VIRUS</u>

Hon Parliamentary Secretary, Ministerial Assistant to the Hon Minister, MHA, Financial Specialist, PS, Home Affairs & Education and PS, Finance remained.

Council agreed in principle to defer the payment of customs duties on food, beverages and all basic necessities being imported in Anguilla at this time due to the COVID-19 virus, subject to consultation with the Ministry of Finance and the Customs Department.
