  - (c) refusal is justified on the grounds of restricted returnability, medical grounds, criminal record, because the holder is subject to a deportation order or because exclusion would be conductive to the public good
- C If you intend to stay in Anguilla longer than 6 months you may be required to undergo a medical examination before an entry clearance is issued. The issue of an entry clearance does not exempt the holder from being medically examined at the port of entry to Anguilla, if this is considered necessary.
